Sunday 15 December

- **Moderator** | Today the Moderator will be leading services at Tartaraghan (celebrating its 200th anniversary) and a carol service at Magherally. Pray for the life of these two congregations, giving thanks for their history and witness over many years and for their ongoing ministry and mission in their respective communities.
- Worship as witness this Christmas | 'When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them.' Luke 2:17-18. Pray that our Christmas worship will be a means of spreading the word as a witness to those who only attend at this time of year.

Monday 16 December

- **Diane Cusick, global mission worker, Zambia** | Give thanks that Diane has arrived back safely in Zambia after home assignment and pray that she would know continued good health. Give thanks for the new school building undergoing construction in Ndola and for congregations in Zambia and Ireland who have been contributing to building this Early Childhood Development Centre.

Pray for the lecturers as they train men and women for ministry in various Reformed or Protestant denominations. Pray for newer families who have recently started coming to church that they would be willing to invest in the life of the church family. Pray for the process of electing new elders, that God would give his wisdom and direction in this important decision.

Pray that the students will have rest over the Christmas break after a busy season of events and studies. Friday 20 December

- **Financial concerns** | With Christmas coming and increases in household costs, many families are finding that income from wages simply aren't enough to keep pace. This often leads to borrowing money & the accumulation of debts which they see no way of repaying. Pray for families in this situation and for organisations such as Christians Against Poverty (CAP), which provide advice, help and hope.
- **Experiencing loss** | Pray that those feeling the pain of loss, or dealing with trauma, whether recent or from long ago, would know and be assured of the hope and restoration that Jesus, Light of the World, can bring this Christmas.

Saturday 21 December

- **General Council** | As Christmas Day approaches, pray that ministers, elders and members throughout the congregations of PCI might know special times of worship in our church families as well as a time of refreshment and rest.
- **Training in Ministry** | Give thanks for the completion of another term at Union College, & pray for students & staff that they would be blessed with rest & refreshment over the Christmas break. Pray too for those in congregational placements that they would benefit from being part of the church family that they are placed in both for their own walk with the Lord, and their preparation for ministry.
