Sunday 30 March

- **Moderator** | Today the Moderator will be leading the service at Muckamore Presbyterian Church. Pray for the congregation and their minister, Rev Stephen McNie, and for the ongoing ministry, mission and witness of that church in the Muckamore area and beyond.

Pray too for families, many of whom have had compounded challenges arising from covid restrictions.
